Our goal was to impact up to 50 academically at risk or economically disadvantaged students from South Elementary School through intentional focus on improved reading, mathematics, positive youth development, parent/family engagement and community partnerships. We exceeded our enrollment goal and currently have 55 students enrolled with additional students on a waiting list.
